



TO COME *in Air Pick-Up*

All American now has on file with the Civil Aeronautics Board applications to carry passengers on Air Pick-Up routes. It has acquired twin-engine aircraft to conduct this service. The company also is planning conventional passenger operations over short-haul routes.

Another step ahead: Night Pick-Up operations. All American has evolved a method of lighting ground stations for night operations which is a near eventuality.

Another development is the use of Air Pick-Up with gliders for commercial cargo. Gliders can land in rural areas too small for power planes, be loaded with fresh produce, picked up and towed to markets. They can be used in mining, lumbering, fishing and construction. Air Pick-Up will also provide the key to unlock areas of rich natural resources now considered inaccessible.

Wartime operations demonstrated that cargo gliders can be picked up from water as easily as from land with All American Air Pick-Up equipment.
