AIR SERVICE with or without Airports

THE great utility of Air Pick-Up in providing service to communities with or without airports is graphically illustrated in this panorama of how a Pick-Up flight operates.

The flight starts in the morning at the main airline airport (left background) where mail and express accumulated overnight from all the nation are loaded for route stations. By Air Pick-Up these stations receive their air mail and air express the same day it reaches the terminal city.

At each route point a messenger collects cargo at the local express agency, mail from the Post
