

MISS PITTSBURGH MEMORABILIA

This piece of fabric is from the cover removed from Miss Pittsburgh, the 1927 WACO-9, that was the first airplane to carry airmail from Pittsburgh to Cleveland on April 21, 1927. The airplane is being restored at the Pittsburgh Institute of Aeronautics for display in an aviation museum. This airplane is one of three: Miss Pittsburgh, Miss McKeesport, and Miss Youngstown, that were owned by Clifford Ball who was awarded the airmail contract in the late 1920's. Miss Pittsburgh is part of the aviation pioneer history that has made Western Pennsylvania a foundation block in the aviation industry itself.
